



This scarf is knit in an easy diagonal pattern with a chunky texture while staying lightweight. Make it long so it can be folded or wrapped for extra warmth. A great gift!



Row 7: (K3, p3) across.

Row 8: (K3, p3) across.

Row 9: (P1, k3, p2) across.

Row 10: (K2, p3, k1) across.

Row 11: (P2, k3, p1) across.

Row 12: (K1, p3, k2) across.

Repeat Rows 1-12 for pattern

Scarf

Cast on 36 sts.

Work in Pattern Stitch until scarf measures approximately 60" (152 cm) or desired length.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es); RS = right side; p = purl; k = knit

SIZE

7" (18 cm) wide x 60" (152 cm) long

MATERIALS

- Yarn: we used Caron® International's Simply Soft, available at Walmart - #9730 Autumn Red - 1 skein
- Boye® single point knitting needles, size US 8 (5mm), or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Boye® hand sewing tapestry needle

GAUGE

In stockinette stitch, 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) Take time to check your gauge.

DIRECTIONS

Pattern Stitch

Row 1 (RS): (P3, k3) across.

Row 2: (P3, k3) across.

Row 3: (K1, p3, k2) across.

Row 4: (P2, k3, p1) across.

Row 5: (K2, p3, k1) across.

Row 6: (P1, k3, p2) across.
