

how-to project: foggy crochet scarf

MATERIALS NEEDED

- #7 Jumbo weight yarn: Red Heart Grande (78% acrylic/22% wool, 5.29 oz [150 g], 46 yd [42 m]) 6 skeins color 402 Foggy
- Boye® Size Q [15mm] crochet hook
- Yarn needle

GAUGE

5 dc = 4".

Gauge is not critical for this project.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

9" [23 cm] wide x 110" [279 cm] long.

PATTERN NOTE

Ch-3 turning ch counts as dc throughout; when beginning the row, skip the st at the base of the chain.

DIRECTIONS

Ch 13.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—11 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in each st across ending last st in top of tch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, *ch 5, skip 1 st, sc in next st; rep from * across ending last sc in top of tch, turn—5 ch-spaces.

Row 4: Ch 3, sc in next ch-5 space, *ch 1, sc in next ch-5 space; rep from * across, ending dc in last sc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in each sc and ch-1 space across, ending last st in top of tch, turn—11 dc.

Row 6: Ch 3, dc in each st across, ending last st in top of tch, turn.

Repeat Rows 3-6 fifteen more times.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch—chain; cm—centimeter(s);
dc—double crochet; g—gram(s);
mm—millimeter(s); oz—ounce(s);
rep—repeat; sc—single crochet;
st(s)—stitch(es); tch—turning chain;
yd—yard(s)
