FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

14" [35.5 cm] long x 14" [35.5 cm] wide by 3" [7.5 cm] deep

MATERIALS

- **#4 medium weight yarn:** Lion Brand Kitchen Cotton (100% cotton, 2 oz [57 g], 99 yd [90 m]), 3 skeins color 98 Vanilla (A), 1 skein color 157 Citrus (B), 1 skein color 148 Tropic Breeze (C), 1 skein color 106 Blueberry (D)
- Boye® size US H [5 mm], or size needed to obtain gauge.
- 2 Brown microfiber handles with rings
- 4 Brown microfiber purse tabs
- Yarn needle

GAUGE

Rnds 1-4 = 4 1/4" [11 cm] square

To save time, take time to check gauge.

DIRECTIONS

FRONT AND BACK PANELS

(Make 2)

With B, ch 5, sl st in first ch to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), 2 dc in ring, (ch 3, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 1, join with hdc in top of beg ch (counts as ch-3 space throughout)—12 dc.

Rnd 2: With A, ch 3, 2 dc around post of hdc, *ch 1, skip 3 dc, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner space; rep from * around, ending ch 1, 3 dc in first space, ch 1, join with hdc in top of beg ch—24 dc.

Rnd 3: With C, ch 3, 2 dc around post of hdc, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-space, ch 1**, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner space; rep from * around ending last rep at **, 3 dc in first space, ch 1, join with hdc in top of beg ch—36 dc.

Rnd 4: With D, ch 3, 2 dc around post of hdc, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next space) twice, ch 1**, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner space; rep from * around ending last rep at **, 3 dc in first space, ch 1, join with hdc in top of beg ch—48 dc.

Rnd 5: With B, ch 3, 2 dc around post of hdc, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next space) 3 times, ch 1**, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner space; rep from * around ending last rep at **, 3 dc in first space, ch 1, join with hdc in top of beg ch—60 dc.

Continue in established color pattern (B, A, C, D) through Rnd 14.

Rnd 6: With next color in sequence, ch 3, 2 dc around post of hdc, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next space) to corner space, ch 1**, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner space; rep from * around ending last rep at **, 3 dc in first space, ch 1, join with hdc in top of beg ch—72 dc.

Rnds 7-14: Rep Rnd 6—168 dc. Do not fasten off at the end of Rnd 14.

Rnd 15: With A, ch 1, 3 sc around post of hdc, *(skip next dc, sc in next dc, skip next dc, 2 sc in next space) to 3 dcs before corner space, skip next dc, sc in next dc, skip next dc**, 5 sc in corner space; rep from * around ending last rep at **, 2 sc in first space, join with sl st to first sc—180 sc. Fasten off.

SIDE GUSSET

With A, ch 12.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped ch counts as dc), dc in each ch across, turn—10 dc.



EASY



Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each dc across, turn.

Rows 3-68: Rep Row 2.

Rnd 69: Ch 1, sc in each dc across to last dc, 3 sc in last dc; working along row-ends, 132 sc evenly across long edge, 3 sc in last st; working along short edge, sc in each ch across, 3 sc in last ch; working along row-ends, 132 sc evenly across long edge, 2 sc in first dc, join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Pin panels to desired size and spray with water to block. Allow to dry. Pin side gusset to front panel with wrong sides facing. Join A to middle sc of corner with sl st. Working in both panels' sts at same time, sl st in each sc around 3 sides of purse to join. Fasten off. Repeat with back panel.

EDGING

Rnd 1: With RS facing, join A with sl st to any st on top edge of purse, ch 1, sc in each sc around; do not join.

Rnd 2: Sl st in each sc around top of purse. Fasten off.

Weave in ends. Using photo as a guide, attach purse handles and tabs to front and back panels.
