

Let's Stay Home

in Counted Cross Stitch

69 stitches wide x 66 stitches high

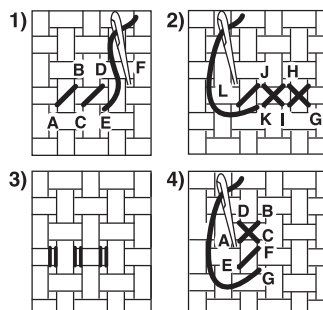
What you'll need:

- 14 count white Aida - 9" x 9" (23 cm x 23 cm)
- DMC six-strand embroidery floss - 1 skein of each of the colors listed below
- 24T tapestry needle
- 6" (15.2 cm) wood hoop
- Dimensions Wood Hoop Stand, #72-75702 (optional)



Work the Cross Stitches with 2 strands of floss, using the color indicated for each symbol. Start at the center of the fabric and work toward the edges.

| ⊙ = 970 orange | ★ = 562 green |
| ◇ = 946 dk. orange | H = 826 blue |
| + = 743 yellow | ▣ = 824 dk. blue |
| ♡ = 563 lt. green | |



- 1) Come up at A, go down at B, up at C, down at D, etc., across the row.
- 2) Work the other half of each cross in the same holes so that the crosses touch at the corners. Be sure that all stitches cross in the same direction.
- 3) The back of the fabric should look like this.
- 4) Work vertical stitches individually.
