



MATERIALS

- EZ Quilting™ Leftie-Rightie Square 4.5" Ruler
- Simplicity Overnight Bag Pattern #2274
- General sewing supplies
- Quilting thread to match fabrics
- Rotary cutter
- Mat
- Ruler

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

5 coordinating fabrics	1 fat eighth of each for patchwork
Gray solid fabric	1-5/8 yds (bag body and pockets)
Gold solid fabric	1-5/8 yds for Lining
Gray print fabric	1/2 yd for handles
Batting	Crib size
Jute webbing	3-1/2" wide 3-3/4 yds
22" sport zipper	
12" all-purpose zipper	

CUTTING THE FABRIC

1. From each of the 5 coordinating fabrics, use the Leftie-Rightie Square ruler to cut 6 – 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares for a total of 30 squares.
2. Follow the directions in the Simplicity Overnight Bag Pattern #2274 to cut out the pieces for the overnight bag, lining and batting.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

All seams are sewn right sides together with 1/4" seam allowance. The overnight bag assembly seams are sewn right sides together with 1/2" seam allowance.

ASSEMBLING THE PATCHWORK SECTION

1. On the right side of the gray bag body, mark a positioning line 3" away from the cut edge of both of the short sides.
2. With right sides together, place one of the 2" x 7" patchwork sections along one of the positioning lines so that most of the patchwork section extends beyond the cut edge of the bag body. Stitch 1/4" from the raw edge of the 2" x 7" patchwork section.
3. Press under 1/4" along the opposite unsewn length of the 2" x 7" patchwork section. Flip the patchwork section down over the bag body so that the wrong side of patchwork is lying against the right side of bag body. Press the patchwork section so that it lays flat and pin it into place.
4. Stitch the patchwork section onto the bag body close to the folded edge. Press.
5. Sew the second 2" x 7" patchwork section to the opposite side of the bag body in the same manner.

FINISHING THE OVERNIGHT BAG

Follow the pattern instructions to complete the overnight bag.
